

## Rules of the Competition “Concours Vidéo La Valette 2018”

1. The title of the competition is “*Concours Vidéo La Valette 2018*”.
2. The competition is open to Secondary School students (**Forms 3, 4, 5**) learning French as a foreign language in the colleges, Church Schools and Independent Schools of Malta and Gozo.
3. The objectives of the competition are the following :
  - To render the teaching and learning of French more interesting aiming towards a holistic education;
  - To encourage the learners to be actively engaged in their own learning process.
  - To encourage learners to discover the history of the capital city of Malta; furthermore, through this competition students will be able to discover the monuments and important buildings of our capital city, Valletta;
  - To make learners aware of the activities that will take place in 2018 when Valletta will be the European Capital of Culture;
4. The competition will be launched by e-mail in all colleges, Church Schools and Independent Schools in Malta and Gozo, on the APFM website ([www.apfmalte.com](http://www.apfmalte.com)) and Facebook page on **Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2017**. The competition will be open till **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2017**.
5. Students participating in this competition are expected to film and send a short **video-clip** (of not more than **1 minute** and **mp4 format**) **on CD** showing a historical monument or building in Valletta. In this video, the participants should be heard or seen and heard promoting the site or monument in French. The CD is to be sent to APFM, c/o Centre Franco-Maltais, Junior College complex, Msida. Only one participation per student will be accepted. The students are expected to write their name and surname, class and the name of their school on the CD.
6. Participants should fill in the **application forms** and send them together with their CD to the following address: « **Concours Vidéo La Valette 2018 Forms 3, 4, 5** », **APFM, Centre Franco-Maltais, Junior College Complex, Msida** or take them personally to the Centre Franco-Maltais by **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2017**..
7. The judges will select 3 winners who will be awarded a prize each: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize.
8. All the participating students will receive a certificate for participation. The winning students will receive a certificate of Merit. The best 3 entries will be uploaded on the APFM website and Facebook page.

9. The criteria for judging will be the following:

- The quality of the video ;
- Originality and creativity ; and
- The quality of the language and its pronunciation.

10. The prizes and the certificates will be distributed during the General Assembly of the APFM on 26th January 2018.
